Login Demo

- This video is the login system of the spellbee application.
- Clicking the login in button with no value in the text field displays an error as seen.
- Placing an invalid email and password displays the same error.
- Placing just an invalid email but the correct password displays the same error again.
- Placing a valid email but invalid password displays the same error as well.
- A valid email and password transfer the user to their account.
- Transferring between the login and register pages the user clicks, “Do have an account? Sign up” and then the correct account they want to create.

Student Register Demo

- Student register form of the spellbee application.
- Clicking the register button with no value in the text fields displays an error as seen.
- Using an email which is already used in the database, an error appears to inform the user.
- Using an email which is in an invalid form, an error appears to inform the user.
- Using an email that doesn't match the confirm email field, an error appears to inform the user.
- Using an access code isn't in the database, an error appears to inform the user.
- Using the password doesn't match the confirm password field, an error appears to inform the user.
- When all the fields are correct, and alert pops up letting the user knows their register and takes them back to the login page.
- When the user logs in with correct value it takes them to their student account.

- Teacher register form of the spellbee application.
- Clicking the register button with no value in the text field displays an error as seen.
- Using an email which is already used in the database, an error appears to inform the user.
- Using an email which is in an invalid form, an error appears to inform the user.
- Using the email that doesn't match the confirm email field, an error appears to inform the user.
- Using a password that doesn't match the confirm password field, an error appears to inform the user.
- When all the fields are correct, and alert pops up letting the user knows their register and takes them back into the login page to login.
- When the user logs in with correct values it takes them to their teacher account.

General Account Demo

- General account for the spellbee application.
- Clicking into the setting account the user can press the help button to receive a help alert.
- The back button then takes the user back to their home page.
- The user is also able to click the help button on the home page.
- As well as the help button for each level in the spelling test.
- Going into the setting page and picking a new default then pressing submit will update in the database and application which can be seen in demo when the test is started.
- Starting the test on level 1 with 1 word.
- The help button displays a pop up to help the user.
- The hit button speaks the word.
- Once the word is filled in and checked the feedback appears.
- The setting default can see to match too.
- The user presses back in this case taking the user back to the home page.
- Going back to the setting page and picking the new default then submitting will update in the database and application which can be seen in demo when the test is started.
- Starting the test on level 2 with 2 words.
- Once the word is filled in and checked the feedback appears.
- The setting default can see to match too.
- Pressing next spelling test repeats the same process.
- Pressing next spelling at the end of the test tells the user it's the end of the test telling them an alert.
- Going back to the setting page and picking the new default then submitting will update in the database and application which can be seen in demo when the test is started.
- Starting the test with 3 words on level 3.
- Once the word is filled in and checked the feedback appears.
- The setting default can see to match too.
- Pressing next spelling repeat the same process.

- In the last word the hide and show buttons are demonstrated.
- Pressing next spelling at the end of the test tells the user it's the end the test telling viva an alert.
- And then they can log off their account.

Student Account Demo

- Student account for the spellbee application.
- On the home page the help button pressed receive a help alert.
- The same thing happens for each level for the spelling tests.
- There is a 'number of words' limit of 30.
- Starting a test on level 1 with 1 word.
- When the word is filled in and check the feedback appears, this feedback matches the teacher feedback set in the teachers account video.
- Once completed an alert pops up letting the user know it the end of the test.
- The same process for level 2 to word 2 however 2 words appears, and they can be longer words.
- The spelling test also contains a help button.
- And pressing hint say the word out loud, however unfortunately like the general account video the recording does not pick this up.
- It the same process for level 3 to word 3 however 3 words appears, and they can be longer words, or could be of longer words.
- The back button will take the user back to their home page.
- Going into the setting page and picking the new defaults then pressing submit, will update in the database and application which is demo when the user starts the spelling test.
- This step is repeated to show more examples.
- The setting page also contains a help button.
- And pressing the back button goes back to the home page not changing any of the default's settings.
- Starting a teacher test goes through the words the teacher has set when they created their test.
- The help button is also demonstrated as well as the hide and show buttons in the feedback view.
- Some of the test has been skipped to save time, only the first three words and the final word is presented.
- The user is also able to log off their account.

Teacher Account Demo

- Teacher account for the spellbee application.
- Clicking into the setting page the help button pressed receive a help alert.
- The back button then takes the user back to their home page.
- The home page also contains a help button.
- Going into the setting page and picking the new defaults then pressing submit, will update in the database and application which is demo when the user adds a test.
- The same steps are demo to see changes in the settings.

- Trying to add a class when there is already 6 presents, pops an error saying please delete a class first as seen.
- This is done by clicking the desired class and pressing delete.
- Trying to add a class when no fields are fill, an error alert appears as seen.
- Trying to add a class when the access code is already used, an error alert appears as seen.
- Trying to add a class when the values are correct, it gets added to the database and appears on the home page.
- Click on the desired class then access with take the user to the individual class page.
- This page also contains a help button.
- The back button will take the user back to the home page.
- The teacher can change the feedback the user sees, this feedback is display in the student video, demonstrating this function.
- Clicking add test takes the user to the test page.
- Trying to add test when no value is in the fields, an error appears as seen.
- Placing all the correct values in the fields, add the test to the database, then appears on the class page and the student page.
- The add spelling test page also contains a help button.
- Trying to add a test when there is already 3 presents, pops an error saying people delete test first before adding a new one.
- This is done by clicking the desired test and pressing yes to the delete alert.
- Then the user can add a new test.
- The user can also log off the account.
